1. How long will the workshop run?

The workshop will start at 10pm and finish at 3:30pm.

1. How many attendees are there?

As with all our workshops, the workshop is limited to ensure everyone gets ample amounts of time to shoot. For this workshop there will be 15 attendees.

1. What makes this workshop different?

Profit is never at the forefront of our focus. Our focus is to deliver awe-inspiring and extravagant floral installations that will help you to book weddings of a similar caliber. Camilla and Rebecca have both built their brands from executing luxurious shoots and networking with high-end suppliers.

1. Can I submit to blogs and publications?

Of course! We recommend doing this so you get the most out of attending the workshop. Camilla will be there to help with this aspect also.

1. Is lunch provided?

Lunch certainly is provided. You will receive a voucher to use in the cafe at Sudeley. During lunch, Camilla and Rebecca will be doing a Q & A for you to ask any questions about their work and the industry.

1. When are payments due?

Payments are split into 2. 50% is payable when you book your ticket (this is non-refundable). The final payment is due 1 month before the workshop. The total cost of the workshop is £750.
